

4K Forrest Street School Supplies

- Change of clothes (seasonal) please label each article of clothing with your child's initials. These will stay in your child's school cubby in case of accidents or spills.
- 1 backpack – large enough to hold folders, library books, etc. (no wheels!)
- 1 wide-ruled notebook – please label with your child's name on front cover
- 1, 1 ½ inch 3 ring binder – please label with your child's name on front cover. No trapper keepers!

Please note that the following supplies will be community materials and shared by all students. No need to label these items:

- 1 pack of glue sticks
- 1 bottle of Elmer's liquid glue
- 2 boxes of non-perishable healthy snacks – examples: pretzels, crackers, granola bars, popcorn
- 1 box of gallon sized zip-lock type bags
- 1 box of disinfecting wipes
- 1 box of Kleenex

Kindergarten School Supply List

- 1 backpack – large enough to hold folders, library books, etc. (no wheels!)
- 1 bath towel – for rest time, send home for laundering (no beach towels or blankets)
- 1 plastic pencil box
- 1 pair scissors (children’s Friskers brand works best)

Please have the above items labeled with child’s name

- 1 large pink pencil eraser
- 1 24 pack of crayons (Crayola has the best colors)
- 1 10 pack of washable markers (classic colors)
- 1 4 pack of dry erase markers (Expo brand)
- 6-8 large glue sticks (no liquid or Ross brand glue)
- 1 spiral notebook
- 1 2 pocket folder
- 2 large boxes of facial tissue
- 3 containers of disinfecting wipes
- 2 packages of snacks (Ritz, granola bars, pretzels, dry cereal and graham crackers, NO individual sizes please!)
- 1 plastic bag with your child’s name on it: bag should include one complete change of clothes (socks, underwear, pants, and a shirt)
